Whether you are beginning a career in IT or have been in the industry for some time, there is a continuous need to stay relevant in an ever changing landscape.

According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics, "Computer and mathematical occupations are expected to see fast employment growth as strong demand is expected for IT security and software development." Experts agree that technological advancements will continue to rapidly grow. There is an acceleration in artificial intelligence, machine learning, robotics, self-driving vehicles, cryptocurrencies, virtual reality, gaming, and online collaborative video platforms. As business continues moving online, demand will exceed the supply of suitable job candidates.

In this Webinar, Prof. Ahmad Abu-el-Haija elaborates on the need in the IT sector and gives several examples of where the job market is moving. After that, Mr. Ian Seward will present the Skills for Information Age (SFIA) as the framework that identifies the skills needed in this rapidly growing sector to assist organizations and individuals preparing themselves for the future. SFIA is used in about 150 countries worldwide, and is available in a dozen of languages. Finally, Mrs. Bernie Scott will present the Professional Certification portfolio which have been designed by industry experts and aligned to SFIA covering topic such as Artificial Intelligence, Cyber, Business Analysis and many more. This session will allow participants to ask questions and get answers from experts in the field.
